

#### **Dear Parents and Carers**

There is ever increasing evidence emerging of the harm caused by unsupervised access to **smart phones** during adolescence. The Anxious Generation by Jonathan Haidt – a pocket full of poison | Health, mind and body books | The Guardian. One immediate area of concern is that Tiktok and Instagram videos are being used to promote the sales of legal and illegal vapes to teenagers, as well as drugs. Another is that these Apps also allow teenage girls (and boys) to live stream publicly from their bedrooms. No child under 13 should have these Apps and those over 13, only by their parents' consent.

Please check your child's phone regularly, ideally supervise it's use and don't allow smart phones into bedrooms. route took us to Easton animal park which gave a nice finish to a full second day. Congratulations to all the students who are new prepared and ready for their qualifying expedition in July.








#### **KS3 and GCSE Art Exhibitions**

# Reading for Pleasure - First Chapters


For this week's First Chapters, students heard the opening chapter from "I Must Betray You" by Ruta Sepetys.
