
Well done to everyone who performed in the Open Mic night this week – superb.

#### What Do We Need?

 Food items that are non-perishable (food that does not need to be stored in a fridge or freezer): Tins, packets and boxes of food, treats, chocolate, biscuits, cakes, all within use-by/best before dates.

- Products for babies: nappies, wet wipes, jars of baby food.
- Toiletries: deodorant, cotton wool, ear buds, shampoo, bubble bath, toothpaste, soap, face cream.
- Anything else that you think a family may need in a food parcel.


